

How can I use this with my children?

Download, print and put up this prime numbers poster to help your child remember what prime numbers are and how to recognise them. The poster shows prime numbers up to 100.

How does this help my children's learning?

This poster is a visual way of reinforcing the concept of prime numbers – numbers that can only be divided by 1 and themselves. Recognising prime numbers is a key objective in the year 5 curriculum.

Ideas for further learning:

Investigate what the prime numbers up to 100 are giving reasons for your answers. Next research how the ancient Greeks discovered prime numbers and what method they used.



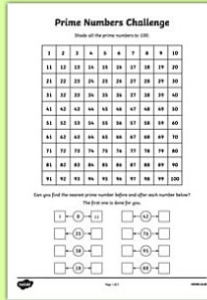
Prime Numbers

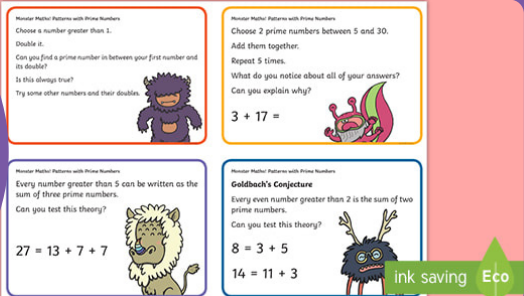

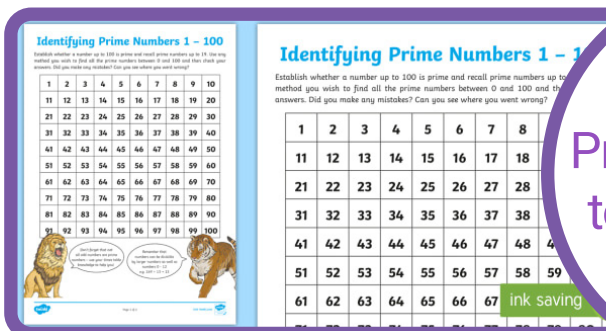
