



Blackmore Primary School School Uniform Requirements September

GIRL'S UNIFORM

- Grey skirt or pinafore dress or grey trousers
- White shirt or Polo shirt
- Red School sweatshirt/cardigan
- Plain grey or red tights or plain white socks and sensible plain black shoes – ***no ballerina style allowed***
- **Small** red or white hair bands/bows are allowed.

No nail varnish or gel nails are allowed.

Summer - Red gingham dress or white polo shirt with grey skirt and plain white socks

BOY'S UNIFORM

- Grey trousers
- White shirt or polo shirt
- Red School sweatshirt/jumper
- Plain grey socks and sensible plain black shoes – ***no trainers or trainer style shoes allowed***

Summer – Grey shorts

Hair below chin length must be tied up, regardless of gender. No extreme/fashion haircuts are allowed (including shaved sides, tramlines or designs).

During the winter months, a sensible **plain, dark coloured outdoor school coat or Blackmore School coat is required.** Our NO COAT, NO PLAY policy will apply.

Years R – 5 must have the Blackmore School book bag. Year 6 are permitted to use a small sized rucksack instead. Book bags available from the school office.

P.E. KIT (Boys and Girls)

- Red Shorts
- White T-shirt with school logo
- Plain grey school tracksuits for outdoor PE
- Plimsolls for some indoor PE lessons
- Trainers or plimsolls for outdoor lessons
- Small drawstring PE bag / swimming bag

SWIMWEAR

- **Plain black sports swimming costume/trunks** (not loose shorts)
- Towel
- Swimming hat (boys and girls) in house colour

Children will not be able to participate in PE / swimming lessons if they do not have their kit. Children will be expected to continue with written work or study if not participating in PE. There will be no phone calls home for forgotten kit. The lending of kit (where possible) is at the Headteacher's discretion.

Jewellery must not be worn to school. The only exception is one pair of small plain gold or silver stud earrings (no bigger than 1/2 cm).

Health and Safety Regulations allow children to wear small studs provided they can remove these earrings themselves for all Physical Education lessons. Children will not be allowed to participate in PE lessons or sporting clubs if they are wearing any jewellery. To ensure that children do not miss out on any of the PE Curriculum, we advise that if you are considering piercing your child's ears, that it is done at the beginning of the summer holidays to allow for healing time.
